Be part of the fight to end the heart ache children, their siblings and their parents must endure to bring an end to this dreaded and hateful disease.

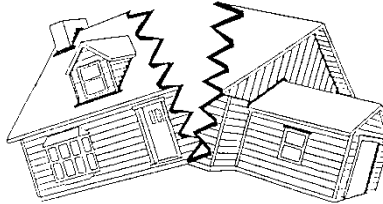
